Psalms 1:1-3 Blessed *is* the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. ²But his delight *is* in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night. ³And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.

Psalms 1:1-3 [Allen-Ps-1] HAPPY the man, whose cautious feet Shun the broad way, that sinners go, Who hates the place, where atheists meet, And fears to talk, as scoffers do. ²He loves to employ his morning light Among the statutes of the Lord, And spends the wakeful hours of night, With pleasure pond'ring o'er the word. ³He, like a plant by gentle streams, Shall flourish in immortal green, And heav'n will shine, with kindest beams, On every work, his hands begin.

Psalms 1:1-3 [Allen-Ps-2] BLEST is the man, whose feet ne'er stray, Misguided by advice unmeet, Who stands not in the sinners' way, Nor sits in daring scoffer's seat. ²To him God's laws give pure delight. And ev'ry day his thoughts employ, Or, pond'ring heav'nly truth at night, Sweet visions wrap his soul in joy. ³This man is like the wide-spread tree. That strikes its root by river's side; His leaves, all green, no frost shall see, His fruit and honors shall abide.

Psalms 1:1-3 [Allen-Ps-3] BLEST is the man, that shuns the place, Where sinners love to meet, Who fears to tread their wicked ways, And hates the scoffer's seat. ²But in the statutes of the Lord Has plac'd his chief delight; By day he reads or hears the word, And meditates by night. ³He, like a plant of gen'rous kind, By living waters' side, Safe from the storms and blasting wind, Shall spread his branches wide.

Psalms 1:1-3 [Allen-Ps-4] THE man is ever blest, Who shuns the sinners' ways, Who in their counsels doth not rest, Nor takes the scorner's place: ²But doth God's law survey And study with delight, Amidst the labors of the day, And watches of the night. ³He, like a tree, shall thrive, With waters near the root: Fresh as the leaf his name shall live, His works are heav'nly fruit.

Psalms 1:1-3 [Allen-Ps-5] THAT man is blest alway, Who shuns advice unmeet, Who stands not in the sinner's way, Nor sits in scorners' seat. ²He reads God's word with awe. And yet with pure delight; Each day he meditates the law. And ponders it at night. ³He's like the wide-branch'd tree, That grows by river's side; His green leaf fadeless you may see. His fruit comes in its tide.

Psalms 1:1-3 [AMPC] Blessed (happy, fortunate, prosperous, and enviable) is the man who walks *and* lives not in the counsel of the ungodly [following their advice, their plans and purposes], nor stands [submissive and inactive] in the path where sinners walk, nor sits down [to relax and rest] where the scornful [and the mockers] gather. ²But his delight *and* desire are in the law of the Lord, and on His law (the precepts, the instructions, the teachings of God)

he habitually meditates (ponders and studies) by day and by night. ³And he shall be like a tree firmly planted [and tended] by the streams of water, ready to bring forth its fruit in its season; its leaf also shall not fade *or* wither; and everything he does shall prosper [and come to maturity].

Psalms 1:1-3 [Aston-Ps] How blessed! that wicked counsel ne'er obeys, Nor leads a careless life in sinner's ways, Nor, sitting in their chair, full fraught with pride, Will scornfully the righteous deride; ²But makes God's holy law his soul's delight, Recording them each day, and every night. ³He shall be like the fruitful tree, which grows Upon a bank, by which a river flows; Whose leaf show know no fail; whose fruit deceives No hopeful owner, but exceeds the leaves.

Psalms 1:1-3 [BBE] Happy is the man who does not go in the company of sinners, or take his place in the way of evil-doers, or in the seat of those who do not give honour to the Lord. ²But whose delight is in the law of the Lord, and whose mind is on his law day and night. ³He will be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, which gives its fruit at the right time, whose leaves will ever be green; and he will do well in all his undertakings.

Psalms 1:1-3 [BLE] Happy the man who has not gone by wrong-doers' policy nor stood in sinners' road nor sat in cynics' session, ²But finds pleasure in Jehovah's instructions, and his instructions he studies day and night. ³And he will be like a tree planted by channels of water that bears its fruit in season, and its leaves never fade, and in all he does he will succeed.

Psalms 1:1-3 [CBC] BLESSED *is* the *man or woman* that *never did walk* in the counsel of the ungodly, Nor *stand* in the way of sinners, Nor *sit* in the seat of the *scoffers*. ²But his delight *is* in the *instruction* of the LORD; And in His *instruction* doth he *meditate continually and habitually*. ³And he shall *become* like a tree planted [*in a garden*] by the rivers of water, That bringeth forth his fruit in his season; His leaf also shall not wither; And whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.

Psalms 1:1-3 [CCB] Blessed is the one who does not go where the wicked gather, or stand in the way of sinners, or sit where the scoffers sit! ²Instead, he finds delight in the law of the Lord and meditates day and night on his commandments. ³He is like a tree beside a brook producing its fruit in due season, its leaves never withering. Everything he does is a success.

Psalms 1:1-3 [CEB] The truly happy person doesn't follow wicked advice, doesn't stand on the road of sinners, and doesn't sit with the disrespectful. ²Instead of doing those things, these persons love the LORD's Instruction, and they recite God's Instruction day and night! ³They are like a tree replanted by streams of water, which bears fruit at just the right time and whose leaves don't fade. Whatever they do succeeds.

Psalms 1:1-3 [CEV] God blesses those people who refuse evil advice and won't follow sinners or join in sneering at God. ²Instead, they find happiness in the Teaching of the LORD, and they think about it day and night. ³They are like trees growing beside a stream, trees that produce fruit in season and always have leaves. Those people succeed in everything they do.

Psalms 1:1-3 [CJB] How blessed are those who reject the advice of the wicked, don't stand on the way of sinners or sit where scoffers sit! ²Their delight is in *ADONAI's Torah*; on his *Torah*

they meditate day and night. ³They are like trees planted by streams—they bear their fruit in season, their leaves never wither, everything they do succeeds.

Psalms 1:1-3 [Collier-Ps] How blest the man who day by day From wicked counsels keeps his feet; Who stands not in the sinners' way, Nor sits upon the scorners' seat. ²Jehovah's law is his delight, His meditation day and night. ³He, like a tree in favored field By full refreshing streams made glad, Shall ample fruit in season yield, And stand with fadeless verdure clad; His precious fruit matured shall be; His work all prospered well by Thee.

Psalms 1:1-3 [Cotton-Ps] What the Blessings of the Man who is not walking in the counsel of the Men that are set for impiety! *The Man* who stands not in the way of sinful wanderers: *The Man* who sits not in the seat, of scornful cavillers! ²But his delight is in the Law of the ETERNAL God; and in his Law he meditates both in the day and night. ³Sure he shall be like to a tree planted by streams of water; which in its season yields its fruit: its leaf too shall not fade: and whatever it does bear shall prosper very well.

Psalms 1:1-3 [Cradock-Ps] BLEST is the man, whose honest soul disdains To tread the path where impious counsel reigns, That is the way of sinners has not stood, Nor filled the chair of the imperious proud. ²But makes Jehovah's law his dear delight, And meditates thereon by day, by night. ³Like some fair tree, that near a riv'let grows, And shades the waters with it's spreading boughs, Boughs, that nor wither, nor delusive are, But with their fruit reward the planter's care, He'll flourish long of heav'n itself the love, And ev'ry solid joy and comfort prove.

Psalms 1:1-3 [CWB] Happy is the man who isn't influenced by the ungodly, who doesn't participate in the ways of evildoers and who doesn't scoff at God, ²but who delights in the law of the Lord and meditates daily on God's word. ³He will be like a tree planted by a stream, bearing fruit in season and keeping its leaves in times of drought. The good he does will last forever.

Psalms 1:1-3 [De Witt-Ps] How blest is this man! In the counsel of the wicked he walks not, Nor stands in the way of the sinner, Nor sits where the scoffing assemble; ²But delights in the law of Jehovah, And rehearseth His law day and night: ³As a tree planted in by the trenches of water, Yields fruit in due time, And its leaf does not fade, So in all that he does he shall prosper.

Psalms 1:1-3 [Didham-Ps] HAPPY is the man who walks not by the counsel of the ungodly, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits at the seat of scorners. ²But His will is for the law of Jehovah, who on His law meditates day and night. ³For he is like a tree planted near water-streams, which yields fruit at its season, whose leaves fade not, and wheresoever it shoots forth it thrives.

Psalms 1:1-3 [Driver-OT-2] Happy is the man that hath not walked in the counsel of the wicked, nor stood in the way of sinners, nor sat in the company of scorners. ²But his delight is in the law of Jehovah; and on his law doth he meditate day and night. ³So is he like a tree planted by water-courses, which yieldeth its fruit in its season, and whose leaf doth not fade and whatsoever he doeth he maketh to prosper.

Psalms 1:1-3 [EEBT] The man is very happy that does not: walk as godless people suggest; stand in the way near sinners; sit with them that scorn (God) ²He likes what the LORD teaches. He repeats it day and night. ³“He will become like a tree planted by rivers of water” “It will give its fruit in its season. Its leaves will not fall” “Everything that he does will be very good”

Psalms 1:1-3 [EEBT.2021] If someone does not do what wicked people tell him to do, if he does not join with sinners, if he does not meet with those who laugh at God, God has blessed that person! ²He is happy when he obeys the Law of the LORD. He thinks about God’s Law during the day and at night. ³He will become like a tree that grows beside streams of water. It gives its fruit at the right season. Its leaves do not fall off. Everything that person does will have a good result.

Psalms 1:1-3 [ERV] Great blessings belong to those who don’t listen to evil advice, who don’t live like sinners, and who don’t join those who make fun of God. ²Instead, they love the LORD’s teachings and think about them day and night. ³So they grow strong, like a tree planted by a stream—a tree that produces fruit when it should and has leaves that never fall. Everything they do is successful.

Psalms 1:1-3 [Ewald-OT] Blessed the man who never went in the counsel of the ungodly, nor trod the sinner’s path, not sat in the society of the scorers; ²but has pleasure in Jahve’s doctrine, on His doctrine meditates day and night; ³he is like a tree planted by water-brooks, which bring forth its fruit in seasons, and whose leaf withers not: and all that he doeth, succeeds.

Psalms 1:1-3 [EXB] ·Happy [Blessed] are those who don’t ·listen to [walk in the counsel of] the wicked, who don’t ·go where sinners go [stand in the way of sinners], who don’t ·do what evil people do [sit in the seat of mockers]. ²They ·love [delight in] the LORD’s ·teachings [laws; instructions], and they ·think about [meditate on] those ·teachings [laws; instructions] day and night. ³They are like a tree planted by ·a river [streams of water; full of life, strong, vibrant]. The tree produces fruit in season, and its leaves don’t ·die [wither]. Everything they do will ·succeed [prosper].

Psalms 1:1-3 [GAC-Ps-1] BLEST is the man who shuns the place, Where sinners love to meet; Who fears to tread their wicked ways, And hates the scoffer’s seat: ²But in the statutes of the Lord Has placed his chief delight; By day he reads or hears the word, And meditates by night. ³He, like a plant of generous kind By living waters set, Safe from the storms and blasting wind, Enjoys a peaceful state.

Psalms 1:1-3 [GAC-Ps-2] THE man is ever blest, Who shuns the sinners’ ways; Among their councils never stands, Nor takes the scorner’s place; ²But makes the law of God His study and delight, Amid the labors of the day, And watches of the night. ³He like a tree shall thrive, With waters near the root; Fresh as the leaf his name shall live; His works are heavenly fruit.

Psalms 1:1-3 [GNT] Happy are those who reject the advice of evil people, who do not follow the example of sinners or join those who have no use for God. ²Instead, they find joy in obeying the Law of the LORD, and they study it day and night. ³They are like trees that grow

beside a stream, that bear fruit at the right time, and whose leaves do not dry up. They succeed in everything they do.

Psalms 1:1-3 [Grail-Ps] Blessed indeed is the man who follows not the counsel of the wicked, nor stands in the path with sinners, nor abides in the company of scorners, ²but whose delight is the law of the LORD, and who ponders his law day and night. ³He is like a tree that is planted beside the flowing waters, that yields its fruit in due season, and whose leaves shall never fade; and all that he does shall prosper.

Psalms 1:1-3 [HPAJ] Blessed is the man who has not walked in the direction of the wicked, and has not stood in the way of sinners, and has not sat in the seat of the contemptible (ones). ²But his joy is only in the Torah of Mar-Yah, and he contemplates in his Torah day and night. ³And he shall be like a tree planted by the streams of waters, which will give its fruit in its seasons, and its leaf will not dry up, and all that he does will flourish.

Psalms 1:1-3 [ICB] Happy is the person who doesn't listen to the wicked. He doesn't go where sinners go. He doesn't do what bad people do. ²He loves the Lord's teachings. He thinks about those teachings day and night. ³He is strong, like a tree planted by a river. It produces fruit in season. Its leaves don't die. Everything he does will succeed.

Psalms 1:1-3 [Montgomery-Ps] Thrice happy he, who shuns the way That leads ungodly men astray; Who fears to stand where sinners meet, Nor with the scorner takes his seat. ²The law of God is his delight; That cloud by day, that fire by night, Shall be his comfort in distress, And guide him through the wilderness. ³His works shall prosper; —he shall be A fruitful, fair, unwithering tree. That, planted where the river flows, Nor drought, nor frost, nor mildew knows.

Psalms 1:1-3 [JPS-OT 1985] Happy is the man who has not followed the counsel of the wicked, or taken the path of sinners, or joined the company of the insolent; ²rather, the teaching of the LORD is his delight, and he studies that teaching day and night. ³He is like a tree planted beside streams of water, which yields its fruit in season, whose foliage never fades, and whatever it produces thrives.

Psalms 1:1-3 [Knox] Blessed is the man who does not guide his steps by ill counsel, or turn aside where sinners walk, or, where scornful souls gather, sit down to rest; ²the man whose heart is set on the law of the Lord, on that law, day and night, his thoughts still dwell. ³He stands firm as a tree planted by running water, ready to yield its fruit when the season comes, not a leaf faded; all that he does will prosper.

Psalms 1:1-3 [Lamsa] BLESSED is the man who walks not in the way of the ungodly, nor abides by the counsel of sinners, nor sits in the company of mockers; ²But his delight is in the law of the LORD, and on his law does he meditate day and night. ³And he shall be like a tree planted by a stream of water, that brings forth its fruit in its season, whose leaves fall not off; and whatsoever he begins he accomplishes.

Psalms 1:1-3 [LTPB] A man is blessed who has not gone out following lawless counsel, or stood up following the sinners' way, or sat in the pestilent's seat, ²yet his will remains in the

Lord's Law, and he will meditate in His Law day and night. ³He will be like a tree which is planted by a stream of water, which will give its fruit in its season, and its leaf will not fall away. All—whatever he will do—will prosper.

Psalms 1:1-3 [Lyte-Ps-1] How blest are they who fear to walk, Where sinners tempt, and scorners talk, ²Who in the Word of God delight, And feed upon it day and night! ³Like trees with water at their root, They spread their leaves, and bear their fruit: And thus may we unwithering rise, And ripen daily for the skies!

Psalms 1:1-3 [Lyte-Ps-2] Blest is the man who fears and flies, The broad and downward way, Where impious scorn its God defies, And vice allures to slay. ²Blest, who in God's unerring law, Find guidance and delight; Walks by His Word with daily awe, And ponders it by night. ³Like trees with water at their root, The heirs of glory rise; Their boughs are hung with holy fruit, Their verdure never dies.

Psalms 1:1-3 [Milborne-Ps] A Thousand Blessings crown his Head, Whose Heart all impious Counsel flies; And hates those Paths where Sinners tread, Who God, and all that's good, despise. ²But in his great Creator's Laws He spends his happy Days and Nights; And thence, by Meditation, draws Both what instructs, and what delights. ³All his Designs are just, and blessed; His Hopes, and every Action thrives; And when his mould'ring Clay's at rest, His fragrant Memory survives. So fruitful Trees, near gentle Streams, Their Burthens to Perfection bring, Unhurt by Summer's scorching Beams, And flourish with a constant Spring.

Psalms 1:1-3 [Milton-Ps] Bless'd is the man who hath not walk'd astray In counsel of the wicked, and ith' way Of sinners hath not stood, and in the seat Of scorners hath not sate. ²But in the great Jehovah's Law is ever his delight, And in his law he studies day and night. ³He shall be as a tree which planted grows By watry streams, and in his season knows To yield his fruit, and his leaf shall not fall. And what he takes in hand shall prosper all.

Psalms 1:1-3 [Ming-Ps] HOW blest is he; who never consents by ill advice to walk, Nor stands in sinners' ways, not sits where men profanely talk; ²But makes the perfect law of God his business and delight; Devoutly reads therein by day, and meditates by night. ³Like some fair tree, which, fed by streams, with timely fruit does bend, He still shall flourish, and success, all his designs attend.

Psalms 1:1-3 [MSG] How well God must like you—you don't hang out at Sin Saloon, you don't slink along Dead-End Road, you don't go to Smart-Mouth College. ²Instead you thrill to God's Word, you chew on Scripture day and night. ³You're a tree replanted in Eden, bearing fresh fruit every month, Never dropping a leaf, always in blossom.

Psalms 1:1-3 [MSTC] O Blessed is the man that hath not walked in the counsel of the ungodly, nor stood in the way of sinners, and hath not sat in the seat of the scornful. ²But his delight is in the law of the LORD, and in his law will he exercise himself, day and night. ³And he shall be like a tree planted by the waterside, that will bring forth his fruit in due season. His leaf, also, shall not wither; and, look, whatsoever he doeth, it shall prosper.

Psalms 1:1-3 [NCV] Happy are those who don't listen to the wicked, who don't go where sinners go, who don't do what evil people do. ²They love the LORD's teachings, and they think about those teachings day and night. ³They are strong, like a tree planted by a river. The tree produces fruit in season, and its leaves don't die. Everything they do will succeed.

Psalms 1:1-3 [NET] How blessed is the one who does not follow the advice of the wicked, or stand in the pathway with sinners, or sit in the assembly of scoffers. ²Instead he finds pleasure in obeying the LORD's commands; he meditates on his commands day and night. ³He is like a tree planted by flowing streams; it yields its fruit at the proper time, and its leaves never fall off. He succeeds in everything he attempts.

Psalms 1:1-3 [NIRV] Blessed is the person who obeys the law of the LORD. They don't follow the advice of evil people. They don't make a habit of doing what sinners do. They don't join those who make fun of the LORD and his law. ²Instead, the law of the LORD gives them joy. They think about his law day and night. ³That kind of person is like a tree that is planted near a stream of water. It always bears its fruit at the right time. Its leaves don't dry up. Everything godly people do turns out well.

Psalms 1:1-3 [NJB] How blessed is anyone who rejects the advice of the wicked and does not take a stand in the path that sinners tread, nor a seat in company with cynics, ²but who delights in the law of Yahweh and murmurs his law day and night. ³Such a one is like a tree planted near streams; it bears fruit in season and its leaves never wither, and every project succeeds.

Psalms 1:1-3 [NLT] Oh, the joys of those who do not follow the advice of the wicked, or stand around with sinners, or join in with mockers. ²But they delight in the law of the Lord, meditating on it day and night. ³They are like trees planted along the riverbank, bearing fruit each season. Their leaves never wither, and they prosper in all they do.

Psalms 1:1-3 [NLV] Happy is the man who does not walk in the way sinful men tell him to, or stand in the path of sinners, or sit with those who laugh at the truth. ²But he finds joy in the Law of the Lord and thinks about His Law day and night. ³This man is like a tree planted by rivers of water, which gives its fruit at the right time and its leaf never dries up. Whatever he does will work out well for him.

Psalms 1:1-3 [Parkhurst-Ps] HAPPY is that man who walketh not in the counsels of the wicked, and standeth not in the ways of sinners, and sitteth not in the seat of the scorner. ²But in the laws of Jehovah is his delight, and upon his laws he will meditate day and night. ³And he will be like a tree planted near streams of water, which yields its fruit in its season; his leaf shall not wither, and every thing which he doeth shall prosper.

Psalms 1:1-3 [REM-NT] Happy and healthy are those who refuse to listen to the selfish or practice the methods of exploitation or develop minds that mock God and his designs. ²Instead, they delight in God's methods and designs (laws), they study, adore and internalize his protocols (laws) constantly, like day follows night. ³They are like trees planted by a stream, drawing in life-giving nourishment and producing fruit of a godly character that will not wither or die. Whatever they do flourishes.

Psalms 1:1-3 [Sharpe] Blessed is the man That walketh not in the counsel of the wicked, Nor standeth in the way of sinners, Nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. ²But his delight is in the law of Jehovah; And in his law doth he meditate day and night. ³And he is as a tree planted by streams of water, That bringeth forth its fruit in its season; And whose leaf withereth not; And whatever he doeth will prosper.

Psalms 1:1-3 [Sidney-Ps] HE blessed is who neither loosely treads The straying steps as wicked counsel leads, Ne for bad mates in way of sinners waiteth, Nor yet himself with idle scorners seateth; ²But on Gods law his whole delight doth bind, Which night and day he calls to marking mind. ³He shall be like a freshly planted tree, To which sweet springs of waters neighbours be; Whose branches fail not timely fruit to nourish, Nor withered leaf shall make it fail to flourish: So all the things whereto that man doth bend Shall prosper still with well succeeding end.

Psalms 1:1-3 [Smith] Happy the man who went not in the counsel of the unjust, and he stood not in the way of the sinful, and sat not in the seat of those scoffing. ²But his delight is in the law of Jehovah, and in his law he will meditate day and night ³And he was as a tree planted by the streams of water which will give its fruit in its time; his leaf shall not fall away, and all which he shall do shall be prospered.

Psalms 1:1-3 [Spitsbergen] Happy is that man which walks not in the council of the wicked nor stands in the way of sinners nor sets in the sessions of the scorners. ²But rather his delight is in the law of Yahweh and in his law He recites day and night. ³And he shall be like a tree transferred to the streams of water which produces his fruit in this season and his leaf will not wither and all that he does will flourish.

Psalms 1:1-3 [T4T] *Yahweh* is pleased with those who do not do what the wicked people advise them to do, and who do not imitate the behavior of sinful people, and who do not join with people who ridicule/sneer at *God*. ²Those whom God is pleased with delight in doing the things that Yahweh has instructed/taught us to do. They read and think about Yahweh's requirements every day and every night. ³They *constantly produce/do things that please God* just like fruit trees that have been planted along the banks of a stream produce fruit at the right time every year. *Like* trees that never wither, they succeed in everything that they do.

Psalms 1:1-3 [Tate-Ps] How blest is he who never consents by ill Advice to walk; Nor stands in Sinners ways nor sits where Men profanely talk. ²But makes the perfect Law of God his Business and Delight; Devoutly reads therein by Day, and meditates by Night. ³Like some fair Tree, which by Streams, with timely fruit does bend, He still shall flourish, and success all his Designs attend.

Psalms 1:1-3 [TLB] Oh, the joys of those who do not follow evil men's advice, who do not hang around with sinners, scoffing at the things of God. ²But they delight in doing everything God wants them to, and day and night are always meditating on his laws and thinking about ways to follow him more closely. ³They are like trees along a riverbank bearing luscious fruit each season without fail. Their leaves shall never wither, and all they do shall prosper.

Psalms 1:1-3 [TPT] What delight comes to those who follow God's ways! They won't walk in step with the wicked, nor share the sinner's way, nor be found sitting in the scorner's seat.

²Their pleasure and passion is remaining true to the Word of “I Am,” meditating day and night in his true revelation of light. ³They will be standing firm like a flourishing tree planted by God’s design, deeply rooted by the brooks of bliss, bearing fruit in every season of their lives. They are never dry, never fainting, ever blessed, ever prosperous.

Psalms 1:1-3 [TVB] *God’s blessings follow you and await you at every turn:* when you don’t follow the advice of those who delight in wicked schemes, When you avoid sin’s highway, when judgment and sarcasm beckon you, but you refuse. ²For you, the Eternal’s Word is your happiness. It is your focus—from dusk to dawn. ³You are like a tree, planted by *flowing, cool* streams of water *that never run dry*. Your fruit ripens in its time; your leaves never fade or curl *in the summer sun*. No matter what you do, you prosper.

Psalms 1:1-3 [UDB] How fortunate are those who do not do what the wicked people advise them to do, who do not imitate the behavior of sinful people, and who do not join with people who ridicule God. ²Instead, those with whom Yahweh is pleased delight in understanding what he teaches us. They read and think every day and every night about what Yahweh teaches. ³They constantly do things that please God, just as fruit trees that have been planted along the banks of a stream produce fruit at the right time every year. Like trees that never wither, they succeed in everything that they do.

Psalms 1:1-3 [Wheatland-Ps] BLESSINGS await that man, who never strays Thro’ wicked counsel from religion’s ways; From sinners paths who keeps his cautious feet, And sits not vaunting in the scorner’s seat: ²Nought from its joy his raptured soul can draw, But day and night he scans JEHOVAH’s law. ³This blessed man shall future seasons see His honours spreading, as a verdant tree; Which riv’lets, that divide the winding mead, With fertile flores from plenteous currents feed; He shall with timely fruit unfading stand, And all shall prosper which he takes in hand.

Psalms 1:1-3 [Wither-Ps-1] The man is blest, who neither strays, Where Godless counsellors have gone, Nor standeth in the Sinners ways, Nor sitteth on the Scorners throne. ²For, in God’s Law his pleasures be; Theron, he day & night bestows. ³And, therefore shall be like a tree Which near unto the river grows. His fruits, in season, he doth give, Green leaves he shall for ever wear: All things he takes in hand shall thrive.

Psalms 1:1-3 [Wycliffe-Noble] Blessed *is* the man, that goeth not in the counsel of wicked men; and stood not in the way of sinners, and sat not in the chair of pestilence. (Happy *is* the person who goeth not in the counsel of the wicked; and walketh not in the way of sinners, and sitteth not in the chair of pestilence.) ²But his will *is* in the law of the Lord; and he shall bethink in the law of him day and night. (But his delight *is* in the Law of the Lord; and he shall think about his Law day and night.) ³And he shall be as a tree, which is planted beside the runnings of waters; that shall give his fruit in his time. And his leaf shall not fall down; and all things, whichever he shall do, shall have prosperity. (And he shall be like a tree, which is planted beside the running water; it shall give its fruit at its proper time, and its leaves shall not fall down. Yea, everything, whatever he shall do, shall prosper.)

Psalms 1:1-3 [YLT] O the happiness of that one, who Hath not walked in the counsel of the wicked. And in the way of sinners hath not stood, And in the seat of scorners hath not sat;

²But—in the law of Jehovah is his delight, And in His law he doth meditate by day and by night: ³And he hath been as a tree, Planted by rivulets of water, That giveth its fruit in its season, And its leaf doth not wither, And all that he doth he causeth to prosper.

Psalms 1:1-3 [York-Ps-2] How great his blessings, who the way Of evil counsels hath not known; Nor loved the paths where sinners stray, Nor made the scorner's seat his own. ²But in God's Law hath his delight, And finds his solace day and night! ³He prospers as a tree whose root Is watered by perennial streams; A plant that brings forth timely fruit, And with unfading foliage teems; Nor droops when even drought arrives, One that in every season thrives.
